



RESOLUTION #R25-0422A
A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT

WHEREAS, the Village of Ashmore (hereinafter “the Village”) is a duly organized municipality under the laws of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/8-9-1), the corporate authorities of a municipality are authorized to make purchases necessary for the operations of the municipality, including equipment essential to public safety and services; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Ashmore has determined that it is necessary and in the best interest of the Village to purchase equipment to support the operations and efficiency of the Public Works Department; and

WHEREAS, the Village desires to purchase a 2016 Bobcat T870 skid steer equipped with a Jenkins 84" Skeleton Grapple for use by the Public Works Department, to assist with maintenance and improvement projects throughout the Village; and

WHEREAS, the equipment shall be purchased from Lifestyle Equipment, LLC, at a total cost not to exceed Forty-Four Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$44,250); and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate and efficient to delegate authority to the Public Works Superintendent to finalize and complete the transaction on behalf of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Ashmore, Coles County, Illinois as follows:

SECTION 1: AUTHORIZATION OF PURCHASE:

The Village of Ashmore hereby authorizes the purchase of one (1) 2016 Bobcat T870 skid steer with a Jenkins 84" Skeleton Grapple for use by the Public Works Department from Lifestyle Equipment, LLC (LSE), at a total cost not to exceed Forty-Four Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$44,250).

SECTION 2: DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY:

The Village hereby delegates to Public Works Superintendent Jake Johnson the authority to research any remaining details, confirm specifications, negotiate final terms, and complete the transaction on behalf of the Village.

SECTION 3: FUNDING SOURCE:

The expenditure for the skid steer purchase shall be paid in part from the General Fund “Equipment Maintenance / Repair” expense line and in part from the Water Fund “Equipment Maintenance / Repair” expense line.

SECTION 4: EFFECTIVE DATE:

This Resolution is effective immediately upon passage and shall remain in effect until rescinded or superseded by the Village Board of Trustees.

The provisions of this Resolution are hereby declared to be severable and should any provision of this Resolution be determined to be in conflict with any law, statute, or regulation by a court of competent jurisdiction, said provision shall be excluded and deemed inoperative, unenforceable and as though not provided for herein, and all other provisions shall remain in full force and effect. All resolutions, rules and orders, or parts thereof in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby superseded.
